Our aim was to reach over 1000 individuals through health services, empower 65 youths and provide scholarships to at least 10 recipients among other aspirations. We decided to not just establish ourselves as the latest non-profit in town during our first year, but to accomplish more than many others have set out to do when starting out. We exceeded our goal and reached more people than we could imagine, with the most common comment being “I cannot believe AGIF is only 1 year and has accomplished this much!”*

*We couldn’t have done it without you, each donor’s name is etched into our office wall. You have contributed to all the smiles, tears and joy encountered. Simply saying, “I will give 1% of my monthly salary to AGIF”, can translate into a previously struggling widow becoming self-sufficient, focusing on her business, with her children fully funded; tuition down to their shoes and daily food.*

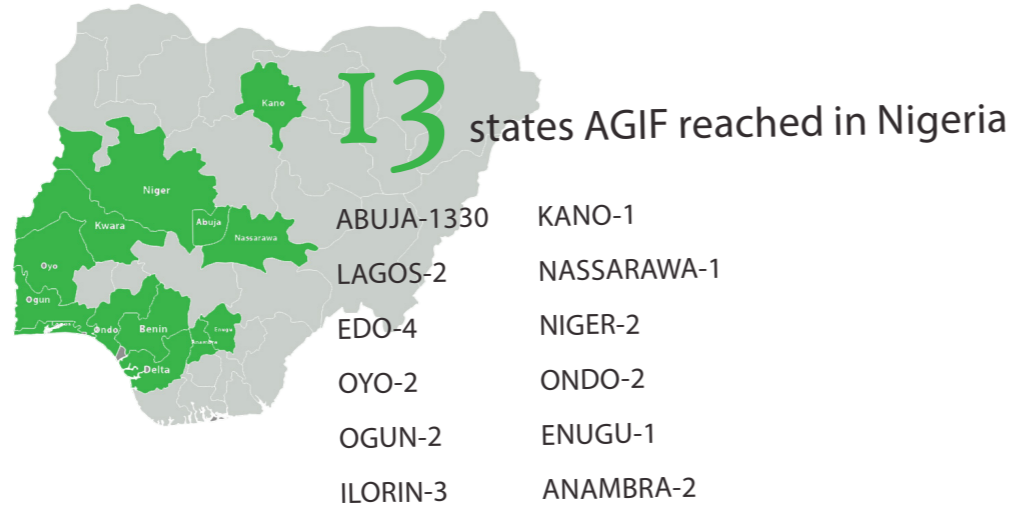


# HISTORY OF AGIF

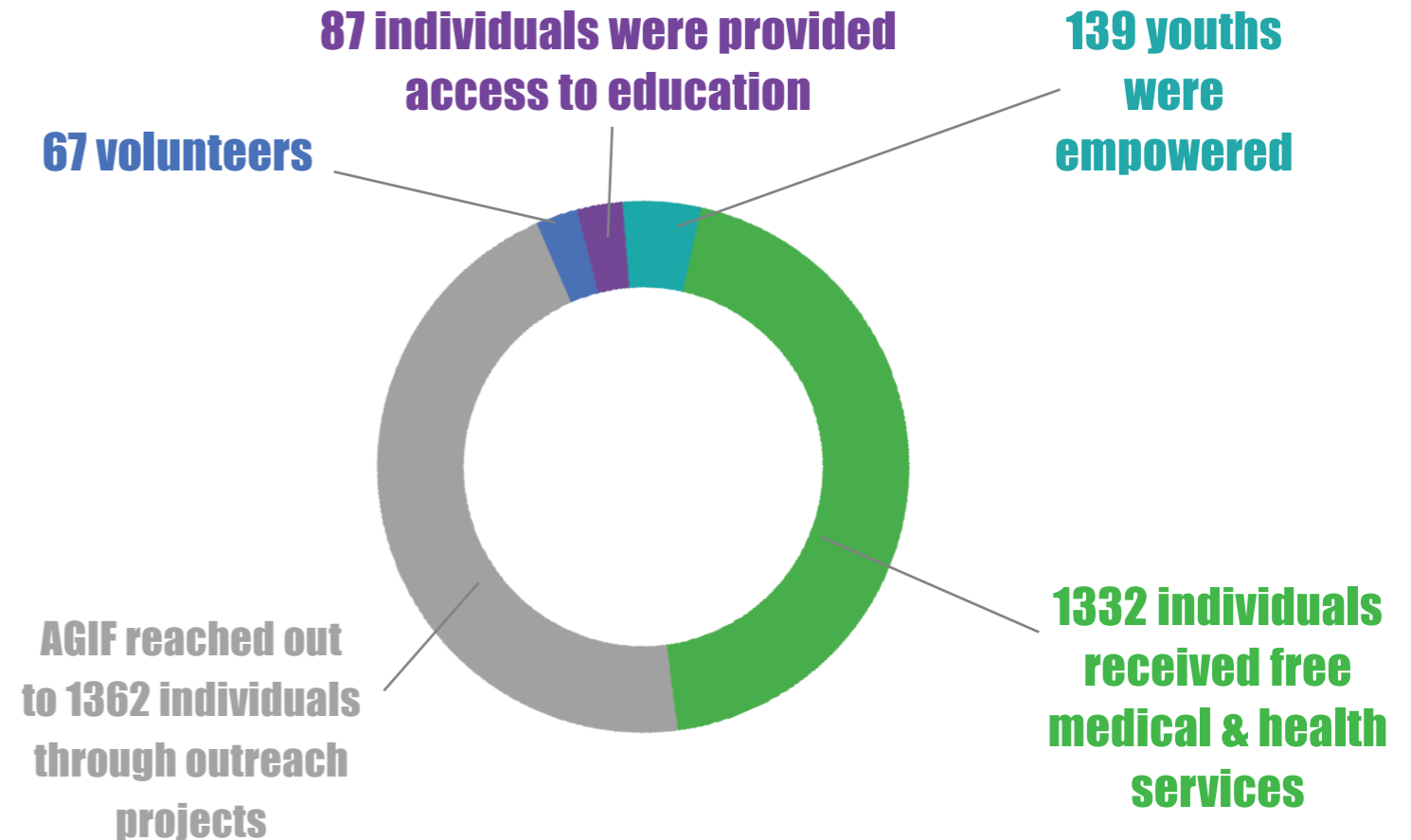
Trained and sponsored several candidates through secondary and tertiary Education, as well as vocational training. The recipients of these scholarships cut across tribes, races or ethnic groups.

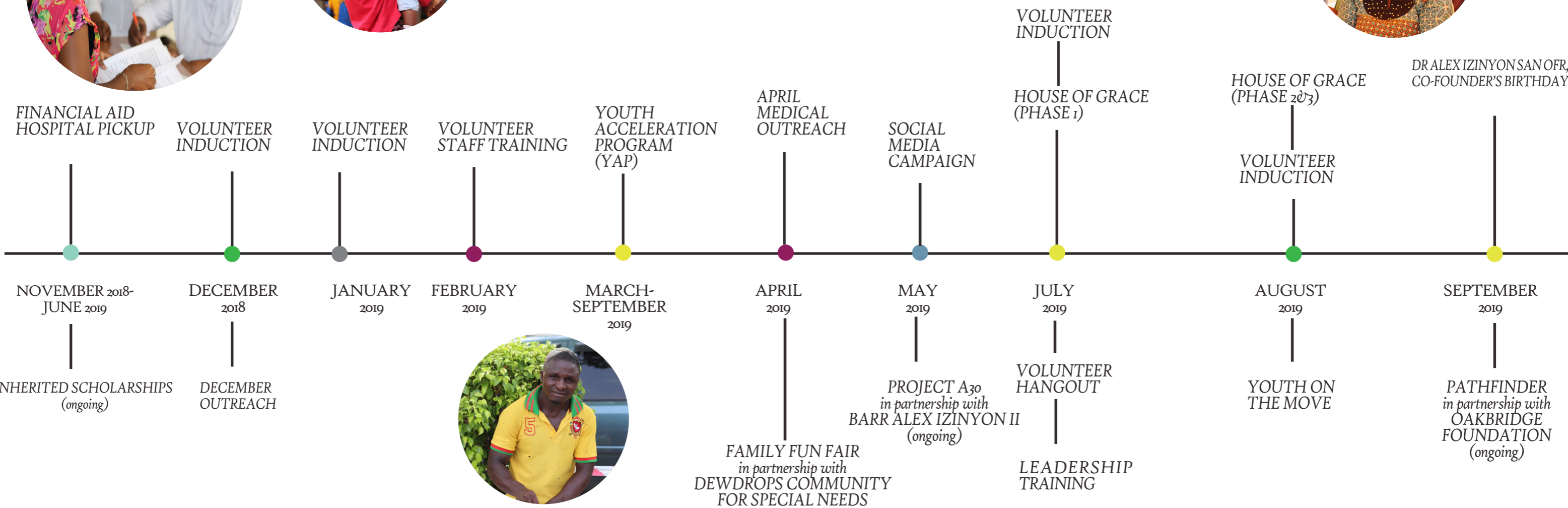
