In our pursuit of creating a world without disadvantaged individuals, where every life is valuable, we decided to plunge into our goal. Our aim was to reach over 1000 individuals through health services, empower 65 youths and provide scholarships to at least 10 recipients among other aspirations. We decided to not just establish ourselves as the latest non-profit in town during our first year, but to accomplish more than many others have set out to do when starting out. We exceeded our goal and reached more people than we could imagine, with the most common comment being "I cannot believe AGIF is only 1 year and has accomplished this much!"

We couldn't have done it without you, each donor's name is etched into our office wall. You have contributed to all the smiles, tears and joy encountered. Simply saying, "I will give 1% of my monthly salary to AGIF", can translate into a previously struggling widow becoming self-sufficient, focusing on her business, with her children fully funded; tuition down to their shoes and daily food.

We have a huge line up in the year ahead, ranging from new projects which include infrastructural development to repeated successes like our House of Grace Annual Outreach. We will continue our efforts to reach disadvantaged communities both locally and nationally. As we grow, we will need more collaborations and partnerships to reach more people (sponsors, media outlets, manufacturing companies, IT gurus and many more). ## **HISTORY OF AGIF**

Dr Alex and Mrs Grace Izinyon were committed to helping the disadvantaged in their communities. Before the organisation was established, our founders reached many lives, several of which are unaccounted for. Here is a brief review of a few accounts:

Trained and sponsored several candidates through secondary and tertiary Education, as well as vocational training. The recipients of these scholarships cut across tribes, races or ethnic groups.

Several outreaches in Bauchi, Kogi, Edo and Abuja (Nigeria) and England (UK) including youth outreaches, children Christmas programmes in underprivileged communities, faith-based outreaches, providing basic amenities to underserved communities, reconstructing maternity homes and many more.




