2020–2021 was an expectation-filled year for the Alex and Grace Izinyon Foundation despite the global challenges. As nations' economies recoiled from the increasing financial turmoil, AGIF remained provident in its mission. During the tough times, the Foundation ensured a cautious approach to avoid unnecessary risks, including being selective in volunteer intake and project selection for the year.

Guided by our purpose to promote the well-being of the disadvantaged, we reflected on how best to serve our communities by instilling our values in everything we do, with focus. The Foundation achieved major milestones, seeing over 75 new beneficiaries added to our various scholarship programs and nearly 1,500 medical items donated to five different communities, including that of the internally displaced persons. As millions of individuals struggled with layoffs due to the pandemic, the widows in our Wi-preneurship Initiative program received access to funding for business expansion and we contributed a significant amount towards a kidney donation.

As we age, the Foundation will continue to remodel our system, innovate current programs for impact and increase collaborations to ensure our strategic plans are sustainable. Thank you to our donors and partners for their tireless support of the work we do. We enter our 4th year with a strong and well-positioned team ready to take on new opportunities ahead.

My name is Mrs Ruth Mark Alemu, a widow with 3 kids. In the year 2012, there was an armed robbery attack at our residence where my husband was shot. I rushed him to the hospital but he gave up the ghost.

After a while, I could no longer cope with the children alone so I returned to my parents' house in Zigan Kuchi, Abuja. I heard about the AGIF Wi-preneurship program at the place where I do some menial jobs to make ends meet, I registered for the program and my life changed forever. The program has been fantastic so far; since we started our training, I cannot even express my gratitude to the foundation for coming to my rescue. Before now, I had no hope of surviving but now the foundation has restored my hope by standing in as my father and husband. The way that the foundation carried us widows through the training, lectures, provision of transport and feeding was just too much. I now have my own

poultry farm business that I manage from my house. I also have a social media account for my business and I usually post and sell my poultry products online. I just want to say a very big thank you to AGIF, may God continue to bless and sustain you for your service to humanity.
